2010 natural gas distribution operator requalification workshops

Kansas Municipal Utilities (KMU) is pleased to offer the 2010 Natural Gas Distribution Operator Requalification Workshops. The objective of the workshops is to provide members with the opportunity to requalify their natural gas operators on a number of common covered tasks. Many KMU members implemented the KMU Operator Qualification (OQ) plan in 2007 to comply with federal pipeline safety regulations. Under that plan, most operators must be requalified every three years. This workshop provides a low-cost solution for getting your municipal gas system operators requalified for another three year period. Assistance with the workshops will be provided by the KCC Office of Pipeline Safety.
